

## **ANESTHESIA/SEDATION AND PATIENTS TAKING GLP-1 AGONIST**

## **GLP-1** receptor agonists

Adlyxin (lixisenatide)

**Bydureon BCise** (exenatide suspension)

**Byetta** (exenatide)

**Mounjaro** (tirzepatide)

**Zepbound** (tirzepatide)

**Ozempic** (semaglutide)

Rybelsus (semaglutide)

Wegovy (semagludtide)

**Trulicity** (dulaglutide)

ALL patients on GLP-1 agonists (for weight loss or Diabetes Mellitus):

- Diabetic patients need to obtain advice from their primary care physician or endocrinologist that manages their diabetic medication regimen in order to maintain optimal glucose control in the week leading up to the surgery/procedure.
  - -HOLD GLP-1 PO daily meds and daily injections on the AM of surgery
  - -STOP weekly GLP-1 injections ONE WEEK prior to elective surgeries/procedures
  - -Procedure/surgery may be delayed or cancelled if any of the following symptoms are present on the day of surgery/procedure: nausea/vomiting, abdominal pain or bloating
  - -Clear liquid diet day before surgery then NPO (nothing by mouth) after midnight

## **Clear Liquid Diet Day Before Surgery/Procedure Includes:**

- -water
- -broth
- -fruit juice without pulp (ex: apple juice)
- -carbonated beverages
- -sports drinks (without protein)
- -clear tea
- -black coffee
- -popsicles (no fruit bars)
- -jello (no fruit or toppings)

Clear liquids do **NOT** include: alcohol, orange juice, milk, coffee creamer, protein drinks, smoothies. Please avoid red and purple liquids.
